- Go to the people and consecrate them today and tomorrow because the Lord will come down on Mount Sinai in the sight of the people.
- b. Put limits for the people around the mountain and tell them 'Be careful that you do not approach the mountain or touch the foot of it. Whoever touches the mountain is to be put to death.'
- c. Only when the ram's horn sounds a long blast may they approach the mountain.
