**Exodus 32:15-35**

1. What did we talk about in the last week's study?

    - d. Moses told them "You have been set apart to the Lord today...."
  
  6. What did Moses do in 3:30-35?
    - a. He wandered off in the desert. He was done with these people.
    - b. He told the people that he would speak to God on their behalf and try to make atonement for their sin.
