6. Does this sound like a familiar pattern? Yes\_\_\_\_\_ No\_\_\_\_\_ Explain. \_\_\_\_\_  
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7. What, according to 34:17-20, is the verdict for their actions?
  - a. Well, at least they had repented...they were trying, so I'm sure God will have grace.
  - b. According to verse 17, they have not obeyed...even though they repented, they didn't stick to their new direction of obedience (See also Ezekiel 33:12-20).
  - c. God says that He will proclaim 'freedom' for them...'freedom' to fall by the sword, plague and famine...wait, that doesn't sound like the freedom they want.
  - d. He will consider whether they have "fulfilled the terms of the covenant" they made before Him.
8. This suggests that God will look at our actions and not just our words (Our songs, our prayers, our commitments, the way we talk in front of our pastor, etc.). Is this right? Is this just and Old Testament concept that was changed under the blood of Christ (see also Ezekiel 33:20, Revelations 20:12, James 2:24, Ephesians 2:8)? \_\_\_\_\_
